Dear Booth Participant:

Thank you for your interest in having a booth at Fun Fest.

The following are a set of guidelines for all booth participants.

1. You are 100% responsible for all costs incurred by your booth.
2. It is recommended that all booths be colorfully decorated; **each booth is responsible for the purchase of decorations.** Student Association will not provide these items. **Each booth must have a sign indicating what fundraising money will be used for.**
3. Your booth must be set up and ready for business on Friday afternoon. The gym doors will not open until 6:30 pm for those with booths. The doors will open for the public at 6:55 pm. All booths must be ready for operation at 6:55 pm.
4. Each booth participant is responsible for clean up of their booth after the Fun Fest. There is a \$20.00 clean up fee charged if the Student Association cleans up your booth.
5. All booths using tickets will be given a ticket container and they will be collected at the end of Fun Fest. If the seal on the container has been broken you will receive only 50% of your profits.
6. Participants are responsible for setting a price for their booth. All tickets are \$.50 each.
7. Each booth is responsible for scheduling help.
8. Tables will be set up in the gym for all participants with names of classes or groups on them.
9. **Booth participants that are having food please be aware that all foods must be vegetarian and peanut-free.** Your booth is responsible for plates, napkins, cutlery, etc. It is not the Student Association's responsibility.
